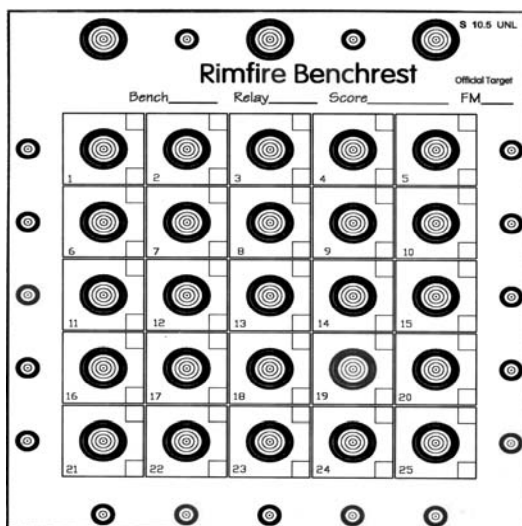
NEWS
