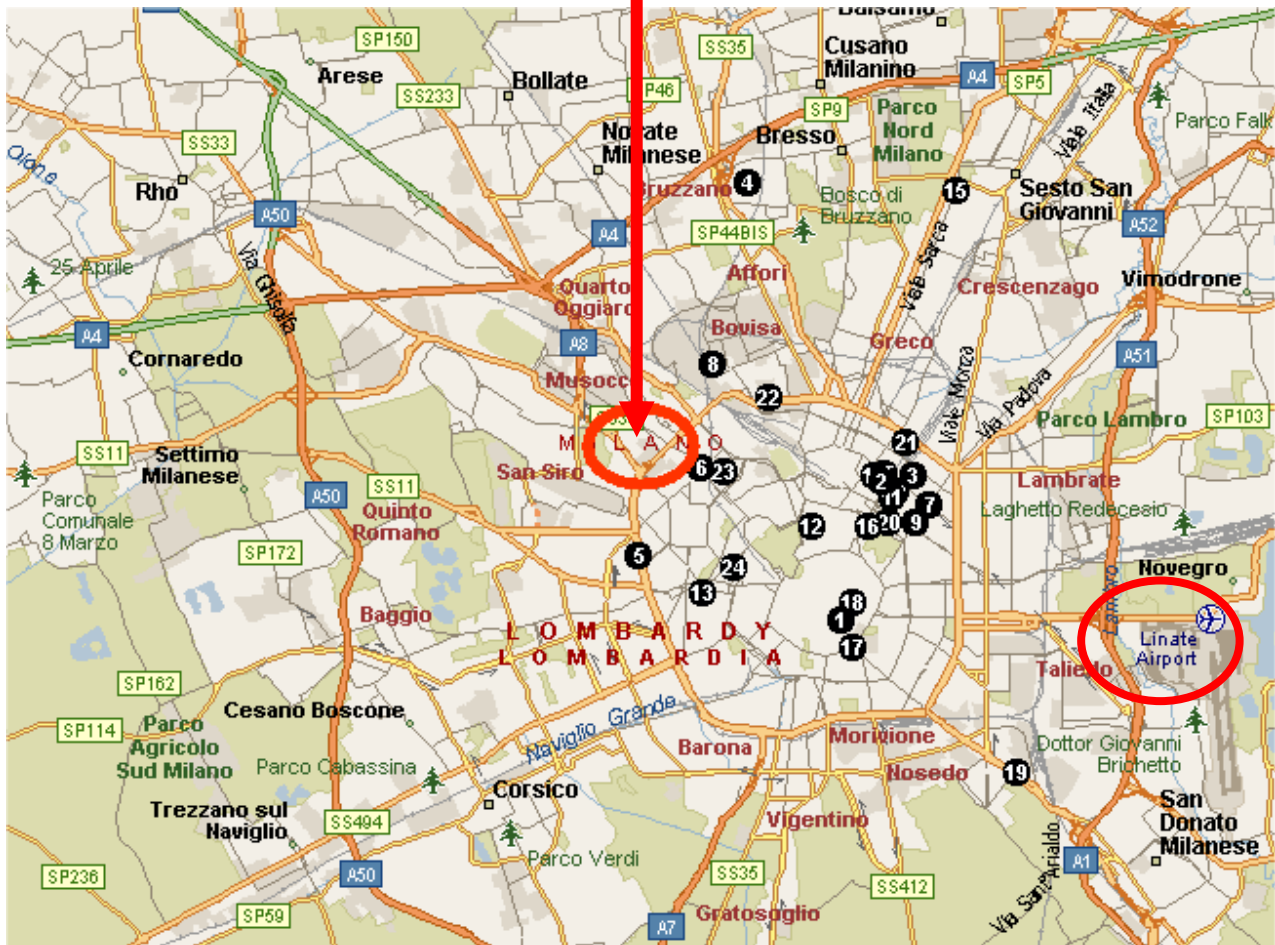
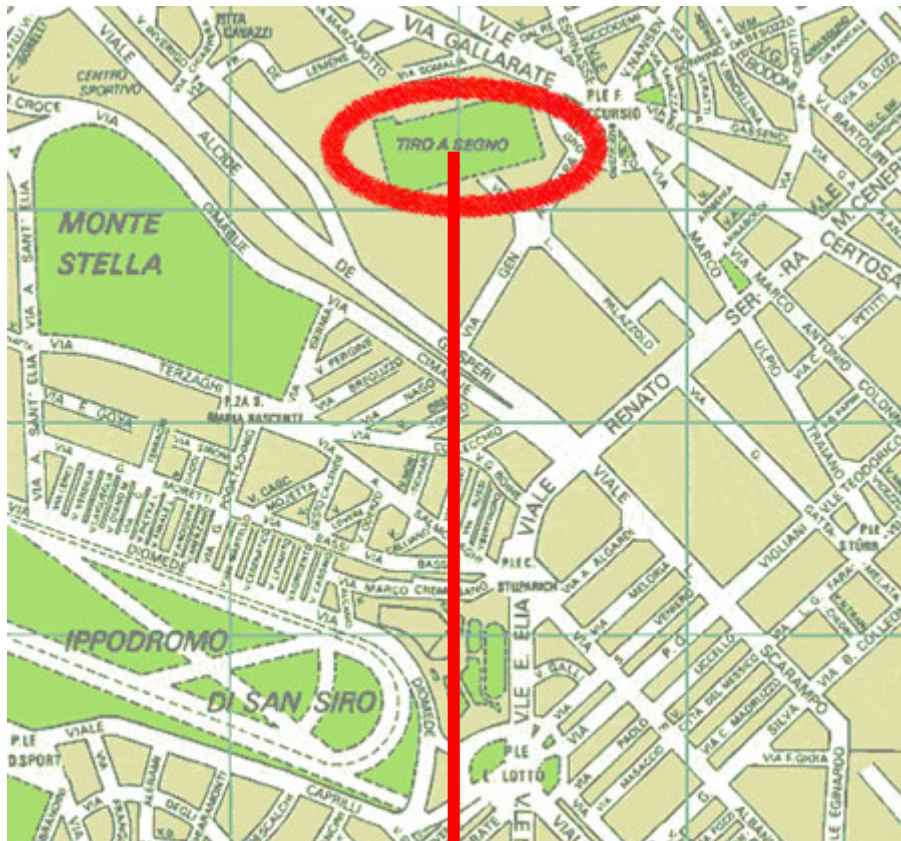
July 27th, 28th & 29th - 2007.

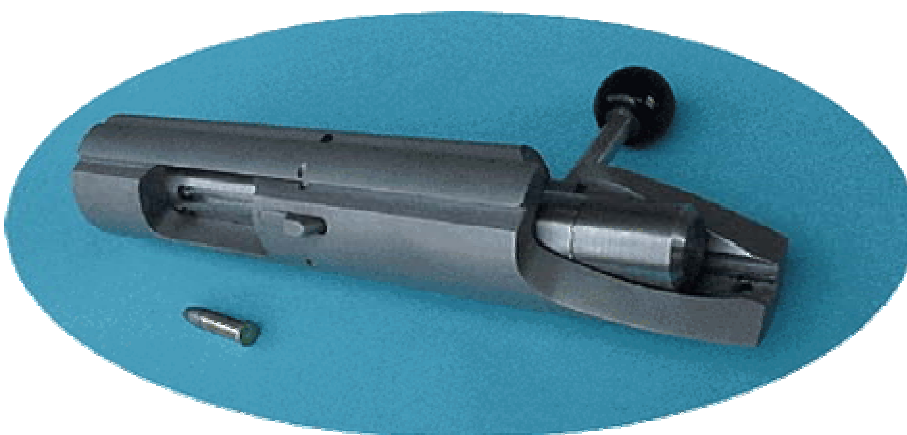

Custom Rifles & Actions;

For those of you out there that are considering a custom rifle or action, it is worth looking at the products below. They are all from the US, which present its own issues for importation, but they are the best on the market at the moment. I will show a few more products over the coming months.

- The action is 1 3/8" diameter by 7" long and is made of 416 stainless steel, the locking lugs are made of tool steel. Both are heat-treated.
- Available with right or left port, but only right bolt
- Port is large enough to get your finger into it
- Anschutz type feed ramp
- Setup with a trigger housing which uses 40X Remington type triggers 3/4" x 18 thread by .950" long
- Action can be glued-in or bedded conventionally
- Back of action offers a very large recoil lug area

The **Stolle-Swindlehurst** Rimfire action was designed and prototyped by Vic Swindlehurst of Acton, Canada. Vic approached the Kelblys to produce the action, marking the beginning of Kelbly's venture into stainless actions. The Swindlehurst rimfire is a top port action which allows for loading from either side of the action without specifying a port side. It is made of 416 R stainless steel and accepts any Remington style trigger in it's trigger bracket. It's design has one firing pin in the twelve o'clock position and two extractors. The loading area is of a V-bottom design to allow loading without feeding the cartridge into the chamber by hand. The action is drilled and tapped for optional Kelbly or Davidson style scope mount bases. The standard finish for the action is high polish.
